Chapter 3 Pinotage 2008	Beautiful fruit flavours dominate the nose of this wine, with just a touch of wood to add the complexity of the bouquet. The fruit burst through on the pallet and lingers nicely to complement the wine. Intense red plum fruit with bright acidity and ripe tannins completing the structure of this wine on the pallet.
